THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AUGUST 2010 AS
CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH IN STANISLAUS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Child Support Awareness Month celebrates the important emotional and financial parental support roles that create a brighter future for our children, our most precious resource, helping them to become healthy, productive, and well-adjusted adults; and,

WHEREAS, Stanislaus County's Child Support program provides important services enabling parents to be a positive influence in the lives of their children, benefiting all who live and work in California; and,

WHEREAS, 162 Stanislaus County child support professionals are steadfastly committed to improving the quality of life for more than 117,000 California children and families through timely, accurate, and responsive child support services, which, in State Fiscal Year 2009-10, collected over \$47 million in Stanislaus County; and,

WHEREAS, statewide nearly 7,800 local California child support professionals are steadfastly committed to improving the quality of life for 1.8 million California children and families through timely, accurate, and responsive child support services, which collected over \$2.2 billion last year; and,

WHEREAS, in recognition of Child Support Awareness Month, Stanislaus County Department of Child Support Services and the State Department of Child Support Services calls upon all communities and leaders to promote the "Get Back on the Road Again" campaign encouraging parents who have had a driver or professional license suspended for failure to pay child support to re-engage with the child support program and their children, and have their suspended licenses restored,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does hereby unanimously proclaim August 2010 as Child Support Awareness Month in Stanislaus County.
