Approval of Amendment to the Agreement with Cinnamon Hills Youth Crisis Center, Inc. for Mental Health Services for Fiscal Year 2010-2011

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

3. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to the agreement to add services and payment for services up to \$25,000, budget permitting, throughout the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2011.

DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services has experienced an increased need for services from Cinnamon Hills Youth Crisis Center, Inc. for the provision of residential mental health services to one additional adolescent for the current fiscal year. The amendment to the current year agreement with Cinnamon Hills Youth Crisis Center, Inc. will allow for these services to be provided.

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services experiences occasional unanticipated increases in the need for services, and the related funding, throughout the year. On many occasions, this additional funding is time sensitive; hence, the Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and execute amendments up to \$25,000 to the agreement included in this agenda item, budget permitting, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2010-2011.

As required by the Board of Supervisors on January 25, 2006, the following table includes a cumulative value of prior contracts with this vendor for the period beginning July 1, 2003 through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

**AMENDMENT TO
PROVIDER AGREEMENT**

This Amendment is made and entered into on September 1, 2010, in the City of Modesto, State of California, by and between the County of Stanislaus, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services ("COUNTY"), Cinnamon Hills Youth Crisis Center, Inc., ("CONTRACTOR") a Utah Non-Profit Corporation.

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR provides residential mental health services to adolescents;
and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has the need for an increase in CONTRACTOR's services due to an additional placement in CONTRACTOR's facility; and


WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Agreement allows the contract to be amended; and

NOW, THEREFORE, effective September 1, 2010, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, terms and conditions hereinafter contained, the Agreement, which was entered into on July 1, 2010 is amended to increase the contract maximum amount by \$46,000, from \$34,000 to \$80,000. These changes are incorporated into the Agreement, as follows:

- I. Exhibit A, Section B, Compensation, Item 1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 1. In consideration of CONTRACTOR's provision of the authorized services required under this Agreement, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR the daily rate of \$60 per client, up to an amount not to exceed \$80,000 during the term of this Agreement.
- II. All other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.






