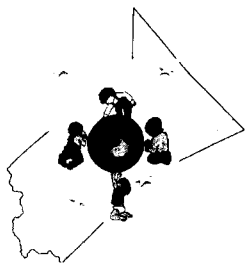

Dear Heather,

Regretfully, I must resign my seat on the SCDLPC. CARES Project funding was drastically reduced (74%), so the Yosemite Community College District opted not to continue the contract with the Stanislaus County Children and Families Commission (SCCFC). I believe this is primarily due to the stipend component requiring continued college education being removed from the 2010-2011 CARES program.

I have sincerely enjoyed my time on the Council and have counted it among my greatest learning and sharing experiences. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the SCDLPC staff for all their support through the last 9 years. CARES and AB 212 made a difference for the early care and education workforce in Stanislaus County and forged the first seamless program Statewide. I know you will continue to move into the 21st century with vision and thoughtful action.
