SUBJECT:

Approval to Declare as Surplus and Authorize the Sale of Thirty-Three County Vehicles and Equipment

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Declare the attached list of County vehicles and equipment as surplus and authorize these assets to be auctioned.
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to deposit all receipts from the sale of these assets, net of General Services Agency(GSA) - Fleet Services costs, in to departmental accounts as appropriate to the fixed asset location of the asset.

FISCAL IMPACT:

It is not known, at this time, what the proceeds of the auction will be. Based on previous sales of similar vehicles and equipment, proceeds are estimated to total \$15,000. An appropriation adjustment will not be necessary as Sale of Surplus Vehicles has been included in the GSA - Fleet Services Division Budget Year 2010-2011 revenue.

**DISCUSSION:**

It is recommended that the Board approve the request to declare as surplus, the attached list of County vehicles and equipment, and authorize their sale. The vehicles and equipment have outlived their useful life and no longer have value as County assets.

County Ordinance 2.24.065 allows for the sale of surplus property with a residual value greater than one thousand dollars upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.

2.24.065 Sale of personal property.

The purchasing agent is authorized to sell, trade, trade in, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any personal property belonging to the county which is deemed to be surplus and not required for public use by the county and which has a value of less than one thousand dollars per individual item without prior approval by the board of supervisors. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, such disposition of surplus property may be made without securing bids or advertising. For disposition of personal property exceeding one thousand dollars per individual item, prior approval from the board of supervisors must be obtained. All proceeds from such sales shall be paid into the county treasury for the use of the county. (Ord. CS 475 §3, 1992).

The attached list represents equipment where the cost of repair exceeds the value or the vehicles/equipment is no longer of use to any county department. The vehicles and equipment will be turned over to an auction company, which will sell the vehicles and equipment and return the net proceeds to the General Services Agency (GSA) – Fleet Services Division. GSA – Fleet Services staff time and expenses incurred in processing the vehicles and equipment will be deducted from the proceeds and deposited to 5021-18510-46000, prior to distribution of proceeds to departments.

**POLICY ISSUES:**

The sale of poor condition vehicles and equipment is consistent with Board of Supervisors' priority of Efficient Delivery of Public Services. Funds generated by the sale of such equipment are returned to departmental budgets for use by departments.

**STAFFING IMPACT:**

There is no staffing impact associated with this agenda item. Transfer of equipment to auction and associated paperwork will be done within current GSA – Fleet Services staffing.
