Approval to Receive and Expend Program Year 2011-2012 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funds in Accordance with the Approved Stanislaus County Strategic Five-Year Local Plan

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Authorize the Director of the Alliance Worknet or his designee to receive and expend Program Year 2011-2012 WIA funds in accordance with the approved Stanislaus County Strategic Five-Year Local Plan.
2. Authorize the Director of the Alliance Worknet or his designee to enter into and sign agreements and contracts to expend Program Year 2011-2012 WIA funds.
3. Authorize the Director of the Alliance Worknet to sign all WIA-related sub-grant agreements, and any modifications or adjustments as required by the State of California.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Local WIA programs are funded from Federal and State sources. Stanislaus County will received a total of \$6,690,520 in WIA funding for the 2011-2012 Program Year. Approval of this item will have no impact on the County General Fund. The Adopted Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 established the Alliance Worknet budget based on an estimate of WIA funding. The Alliance Worknet anticipates adjusting its budget during the Final Budget Addendum process to accurately reflect the County's actual WIA allocation based on the recent notification by the California Employment Development Department.

DISCUSSION:

Workforce Investment Act Formula Funds:

The Workforce Investment Division of the California Employment Development Department (EDD), the designated State Grant Manager of the Department of Labor's Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funding, has announced allocations to Local Workforce Investment Areas for Program Year (PY) 2011-2012. This year's allocation for Stanislaus County is \$6,690,520 a decrease of \$1,168,318 over the previous year allocation. This decrease in funding is due to a 10% reduction in WIA funding at the Federal level and an allocation formula that drives funding to local areas with relatively higher increases in unemployment rates. The Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors must annually authorize the receipt of WIA funds and designate the fund administrator. With approval of these recommendations, the Alliance Worknet will serve as fiduciary agent on behalf of the Stanislaus Economic Development and Workforce Alliance (Local Workforce Investment Board) and the Board of Supervisors in administering these funds. The Alliance Worknet Director will administer the program based on Board approval.

The Alliance Worknet provides employment services to over 13,400 Stanislaus County residents annually at the following four locations: 629 12th St., Modesto, 1405 West F St. #1, Oakdale, 125 N. Broadway, Turlock, 66 N. El Circulo Ave., Patterson. Services include access to job openings, résumé and application assistance, job search workshops, skill assessment, career planning and counseling, and job training. In addition, Alliance Worknet staff provides "Rapid Response" assistance to workers who are being laid off due to business closures and downsizing in the effort to quickly re-establish them in the workforce.

Approval of staff's recommendation will allow the Alliance Worknet Director to enter into and sign contracts and expend 2011-2012 funds in the general administration of the program. Individual contract amounts for the provision of these employment and training services are expected to exceed \$100,000.

Contracts will be approved by the Local Workforce Investment Board and will follow the Board of Supervisors policies regarding the approval and reporting of contracts and agreements.

POLICY ISSUE:

The recommended action supports the Board of Supervisors' goals and priorities as follows:

A Strong Local Economy

WIA funds are invested in workforce development in coordination with economic development through the Alliance Board. This represents a unique approach to improving economic conditions in Stanislaus County.

Efficient Delivery of Public Services

Approval of the plan allows for the continued operation of the Alliance Worknet Resource Centers, which provide employment services to all County residents.

Effective Partnerships

Through this plan, the Alliance Worknet delivers employment and training services in cooperation with the following community partners:

The Stanislaus County Community Services Agency, the Employment Development Department, the Stanislaus Economic Development and Workforce Alliance, Modesto Junior College, California Department of Rehabilitation, Central Valley Opportunity Center, Area Agency on Aging, the Stanislaus Literacy Center, the Housing Authority of Stanislaus, and the Stanislaus County Office of Education.

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO WIA FORMULA ALLOCATIONS—PY 2011-12

The purpose of this Information Notice is to amend WSIN10-62, by adjusting the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) formula fund allocations for two of the Local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA), (North Central Counties Consortium [NCCC] and Napa County). The amended amounts are the direct result of Lake County moving from the NCCC to Napa County. As identified in WSIN10-62 the allocations are based on the allotments issued by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) to the states (refer to DOL Training and Employment Guidance Letter [TEGL] 26-10 dated May 10, 2011).

Outside of the amended amounts for the NCCC and Napa County the overall allotments to California and the amounts available for formula allocation to all other LWIAs have not changed. The attachment reflects the total amounts each LWIA received and updates the allocation amounts for the NCCC and Napa County for each of the funding streams during the Program Year (PY) 2011-12.
