AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL TITLE 25 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE RELATING TO ELECTION CAMPAIGN REFORM

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 25 of the Stanislaus County Code is repealed.

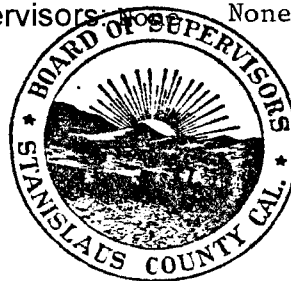

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.


