SUBJECT:

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020, of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending a No Parking Zone on Tenaya Drive, Glenn Avenue, and Sequoia Street in Stanislaus County, Modesto and Salida Areas

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) Find that the subject ordinance change is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Sections 2100 et. seq.).
- 2) Introduce and waive the first reading of an ordinance amending Title 11, Section 11.08.020, of the Stanislaus County Code, adding a No Parking Zone on Tenaya Drive, Glenn Avenue, and Sequoia Street in Stanislaus County, Modesto and Salida areas.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City of Modesto will paint the curb red at the Glenn Avenue and Sequoia Street locations at no charge to the County. The cost to paint the curb red on Tenaya Drive is \$1,360. This cost includes both materials and labor. Funds are available in the Public Works Road Operations budget.

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020, of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending a No Parking Zone on Tenaya Drive, Glenn Avenue, and Sequoia Street in Stanislaus County, Modesto and Salida Areas

DISCUSSION:

The City of Modesto has requested that the curb be painted red at Glenn Avenue and Sequoia Street in the County where their Modesto Area Express (MAX) buses make their stops for the purpose of dropping off and picking up passengers. MAX Bus Stop signs are already in place. The Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Division has reviewed the locations of Glenn Avenue and Sequoia Street. Each of these areas have signs showing the MAX bus stop areas, but vehicles parking at or near these signs are preventing the buses from being able to safely park to drop off and pick up passengers. The Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering staff recommends amending the No Parking Zone to include Glenn Avenue and Sequoia Street to help create a safe area for the City of Modesto MAX buses to load and unload passengers. This will ensure a safe travel way for motorists and pedestrians along these portions of the County roadway.

Dawn Foods at 4407 Tenaya Drive has requested red curb painting on both sides of their driveway due to vehicles parking on either side of the driveway, which is creating a hazard for the commercial trucks entering and exiting their business. The Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering staff recommends amending the No Parking Zone to include Tenaya Drive to help alleviate the blocking of the entrances of various businesses on Tenaya Drive. This will ensure a safe travel way for motorists and pedestrians along this portion of the County roadway.

POLICY ISSUES:

California Vehicle Code 22506 requires Board approval to change and/or add parking zones.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, SECTION 11.08.020
RELATING TO NO PARKING ZONE ON TENAYA DRIVE, GLENN AVENUE, AND
SEQUOIA STREET, IN THE MODESTO AND SALIDA AREA

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Title 11, Chapter 11.08, Section 11.08.020 (No Parking Zone) to add Subsection 536 (Tenaya Drive), 537 (Glenn Avenue) and 538 (Sequoia Street) as follows:

“536 Tenaya Drive. On the north side of Tenaya Drive from a point 230 feet west of its intersection thereof with Riverside Road thence northwesterly 800 feet to a point 1,230 feet northwest of said intersection.

537 Glenn Avenue. On the south side of Glenn Avenue from its intersection thereof with Frazier Street easterly to a point 84 feet south of said intersection.

538 Sequoia Street. On the southwest side of Sequoia Street from a point 320 feet from its intersection thereof with Broadway Avenue, thence southerly 71 feet to a point 391 feet southwest of said intersection.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.



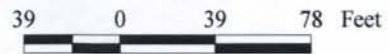

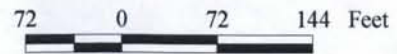

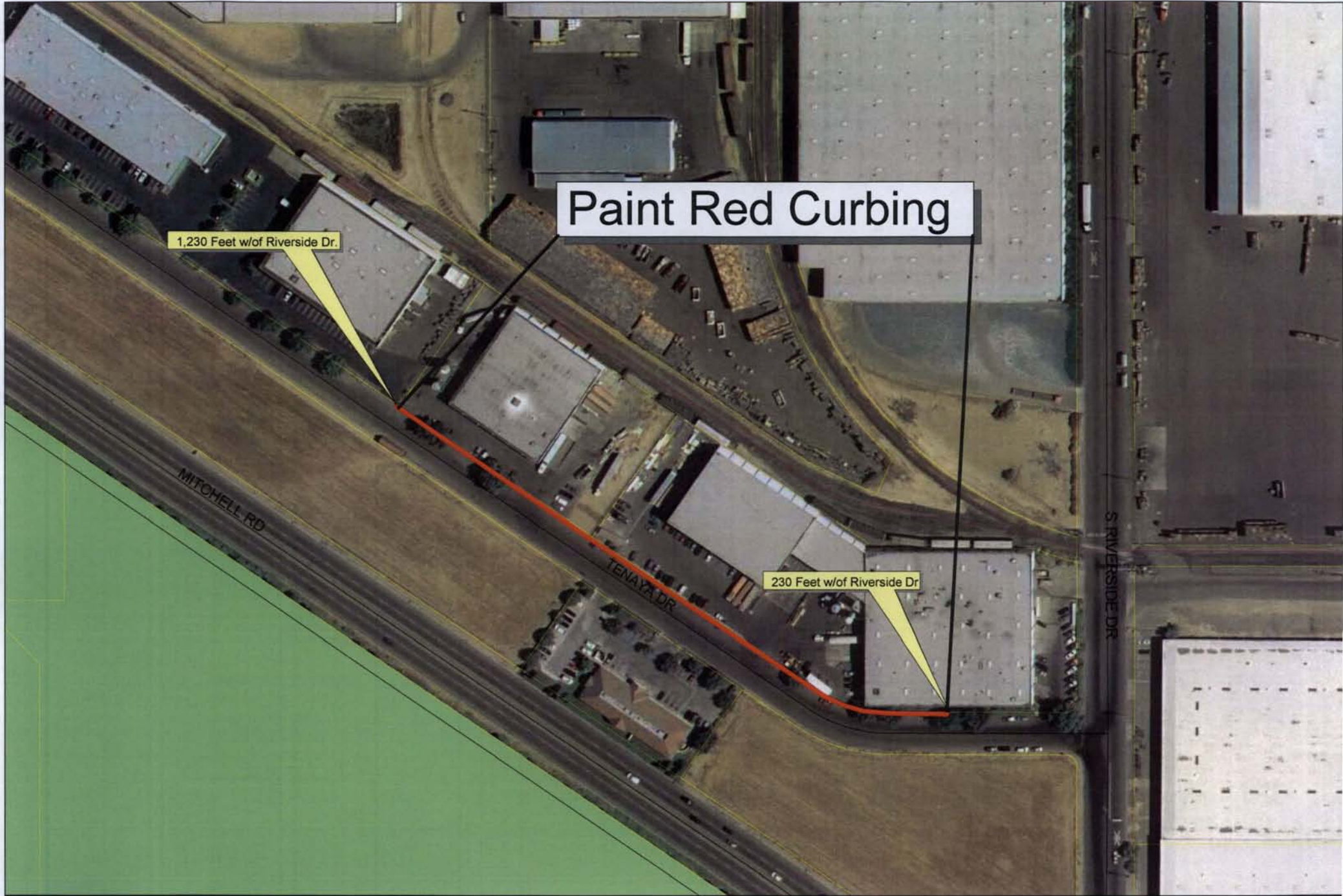
