

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH NEW AND AMEND EXISTING FEES COLLECTED
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION**


THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Fees to be collected by the Department of Parks and Recreation are adopted and amended as set forth in the "Fee Schedule for the Stanislaus County Department of Parks and Recreation" attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated by reference, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for public inspection and copying in that office in accordance with the California Public Records Act.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect June 7, 2012 and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.


