SUBJECT:

Approval to Take all of the Necessary Actions Required to Salvage and Demolish the Commercial Modular Trailer Located at the Juvenile Commitment Center Construction Site

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Authorize the Project Manager to take all of the necessary actions required to salvage and demolish the commercial modular trailer located at the Juvenile Commitment Center Construction Site.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The previously approved project budget for the Juvenile Commitment Center Capital Project included appropriations to salvage a 960 square foot portable modular trailer located within the Juvenile Commitment Center Project Construction site. This County asset has reached the end of its useful life cycle, is beyond economical repair, and has no estimated book value. Consistent with the County's Salvage Policy, the Project Manager is requesting Board of Supervisors approval to take all of the necessary actions to salvage and demolish the modular trailer. The total cost is estimated not to exceed \$9,512 with the disposition of the asset to be funded by existing appropriations in the Capital Project Fund.

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DISCUSSION:

The commercial modular trailer had been previously used by the Probation Department as an annex classroom since 1990 to provide instruction to non-incarcerated juveniles and for use by staff for departmental purposes. The commercial modular trailer has reached the end of its useful life cycle and is beyond economical repair.

The Probation Department has indicated it has no interest in continuing to use the modular trailer and concurs with Staff's recommendation to salvage and demolish the commercial modular trailer.

Consistent with the County's Salvage Policy, the General Services Agency will coordinate the salvage of any items deemed of value prior to salvage and demolition of the trailer.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Existing Capital Projects staff will coordinate the salvage and demolition of the commercial modular trailer.
