

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with the Department of Toxic Substance Control and the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board invite you to the Open House for the Modesto Soil Stockpile Project.

The purpose of this Open House is to provide information to the community regarding the soil stockpiles and groundwater monitoring located south of Kansas Avenue on both sides of State Route 99 in the City of Modesto, and to provide information and respond to the concerns of the residents.

Information will also be available for the State Route 99 Ramp Project currently in construction, which includes safety improvements to the northbound Kansas Avenue off-ramp. This project was temporarily delayed to ensure any soil excavation at this location be managed appropriately.
