Approval to Operate a Stanislaus County Life Jacket Loaner Pilot Program at Woodward Reservoir from May 25, 2013 to September 1, 2013

DISCUSSION:

In collaboration with Stanislaus County Department of Parks and Recreation, the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Team of Active Retired Seniors (STARS) citizen volunteers, and the California State Department of Boating and Waterways (DBW) have partnered to provide a Stanislaus County Life Jacket Loaner Pilot Program at Woodward Reservoir during the upcoming 2013 summer season. Through education and accessibility, the goal is to keep people safe around the waterways.

The 6,667 acre Woodward Regional Park is located in northeastern Stanislaus County, north of the town of Oakdale off of highway J14. The park is developed around a water reservoir that is owned and operated by the South San Joaquin Irrigation District. Overnight camping and water sports such as water skiing, jet skiing, sailing, swimming, power boating, fishing, and duck hunting are the major attractions of the park. Overnight camping areas are designated along the shoreline of the reservoir with full hook-up sites and standard amenity campsites. Restrooms and showers are available near the tent camping and more primitive sites. Day use activities include group and family picnicking, boating, swimming, and open play fields.

In 2012, there were two unfortunate drowning incidents at Woodward Reservoir. On Father's Day 2012, a father drowned in the presence of his family while trying to save his granddaughter. Shortly after that, a teenager drowned while swimming at the reservoir. The two deputies on duty at the time, Deputy Ed Ridenour and Deputy Eugene Day, responded to both incidents. Sadly both victims perished and neither was wearing a life jacket.

California Department of Boating and Waterways (DBW) has partnered with public and private entities to loan life jackets to the public free of charge. The Stanislaus Consolidated Fire Protection District (SCFPD) also has a Life Jacket Loaner Program that is available for pick-up at specific locations. The goal of the program is to make waterways as safe as possible. The life jackets are currently available at the following locations:

Fire Station 32 4847 Yosemite Blvd Empire, CA 95357

Fire Station 34 321 E Street Waterford, CA 95386

Fire Station 36 3318 Topeka Street Riverbank, CA 95367

Seventy-five life jackets have been donated by DBW for the Life Jacket Loaner Pilot Program at Woodward Reservoir. The life jackets are available in three sizes: youth, child, and adult. Each jacket would be stenciled with "STAN COUNTY" and assigned a number. The jackets

would be inspected prior to issuance. The STARS have committed to handing out the jackets on a first-come first-serve basis on Saturdays and Sundays, from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Each life jacket loan would require completion of the "Life Jacket Loan and Liability Form" (Attachment A). Distribution would be conducted from an existing storage area near the main boat ramp and the life jackets would be due for return by 4:00 p.m. each day. If the life jacket is not returned by the deadline, the person who signed the jacket out would not be able to participate in the program for the rest of the season. The pilot program would be promoted at Woodward Reservoir from May 25, 2013 through September 1, 2013. Promotional materials, also donated by DBW, include posters, handouts, coloring books, and stickers.

Upon completion of the season (September 1, 2013), the Department and the STARS will assess the program to determine the continuation of the program in future years.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approval to operate a Stanislaus County Life Jacket Loaner Pilot Program is consistent with the Board's priorities of A Safe Community, A Healthy Community, and Effective Partnerships by partnering with agencies to educate and promote safe water practices.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

The STARS have volunteered to operate the Life Jacket Loaner Pilot Program at Woodward Reservoir for approximately seventy hours per month. The number of STARS volunteers and shifts may vary. The station would be open to the public on Saturdays and Sundays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. from May 25, 2013 through September 1, 2013. No additional staff will be used in this program.

 In 2012, there were two unfortunate incidents where individuals perished due to drowning

- While Sheriff's Deputies responded quickly, neither victim was wearing a life jacket and could not be saved
- Boating and Waterways partners with many public and private entities to loan life jackets free of charge, including three local Stanislaus Consolidated locations: Empire, Waterford and Riverbank

75 life jackets have been donated in three sizes: youth, child and adult

 Will be stenciled with "STAN COUNTY" and assigned a number

- STARS volunteers have committed to handing out the jackets on a first come, first serve basis, Saturdays & Sundays from 12 noon to 4 p.m.
- May 25, 2013, through Sept. 1, 2013
- Done near the main boat ramp

- A "Life Jacket Loan and Liability Form" would need to be completed
- If not returned, the person signing for the jacket would be ineligible to participate for the remainder of the season
- If successful, consider continuing and expanding the program in the future
