Approval to Adopt Plans and Specifications for the 2013 Slurry Seal Project, and Set the Bid Opening Date

DISCUSSION:

A slurry seal is intended to treat the surface of asphalt pavement by placing a layer of oil and rock on top of the existing pavement. Slurry seals extend pavement life by sealing the pavement. This minimizes asphalt oxidation, reduces water filtration and corrects minor raveling and weathering of the roads.

The 2013 Slurry Seal Project will slurry seal approximately 7.31 miles of various County roads. These roads are generally in County pockets and this treatment is appropriate for urban neighborhoods. It will extend the service life of these roads by about three to five years.
