SUBJECT:

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to Include Kiernan Avenue in Stanislaus County, Salida Area

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Find that the subject ordinance change is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Sections 2100, et. seq.).
2. Introduce and waive the first reading of an ordinance amending Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to include Kiernan Avenue in Stanislaus County, Salida area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The application of red paint on the curb along the proposed portion of Kiernan Avenue will cost the Department of Public Works \$100 in material cost in the initial year, with no significant increase in the annual budget for maintenance. Funding is available in the current year's Road and Bridge Operations budget.

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to Include Kiernan Avenue in Stanislaus County, Salida Area

DISCUSSION:

While working with Salida Middle School staff on an issue concerning commercial trucks parking on Kiernan Avenue, Public Works' staff identified that there was a gap in the "No Parking" zone on the north side of Kiernan Avenue near the intersection of Kiernan Avenue and Toomes Road. A "No Truck Parking" zone for this area was previously approved by the Board on January 14, 2014.

The "No Parking" zone requiring an amendment on Kiernan Avenue currently includes one hundred and fifteen feet on Kiernan Avenue west of Toomes Road, it then skips one hundred feet and continues on another ninety five feet. Students are being dropped off in this one hundred foot section of Kiernan Avenue, causing congestion and safety problems near the intersection. The school has a parking lot on Kiernan Ave that accommodates the dropping off of students.

Based on the staff review of Kiernan Avenue and Toomes Road, the Department recommends amending the No Parking Section 11.08.020 to include this one hundred foot portion of Kiernan Avenue. Closure of this gap in the no parking zones will increase safety for students and vehicles near the intersection.

POLICY ISSUES:

This action is consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Well Planned Infrastructure System by ensuring a safe travel way for motorists and pedestrians along this portion of the County roadway. California Vehicle Code 22506 requires Board approval to change and/or add parking zones.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE,
SECTION 11.08.020 RELATING TO RED CURB MARKING – STREETS DESIGNATED
ON KIERNAN AVENUE, IN THE SALIDA AREA

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 Amend Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking – Streets Designated Paragraph 454, to read as follows:

“454. Kiernan Avenue. On the north side of Kiernan Avenue from its intersection thereof with Toomes Road, west to a point three hundred ten feet west of the intersection; and on the north side of Kiernan Avenue from a point seven hundred forty feet west of its intersection with Toomes Road, west one hundred feet to a point eight hundred forty feet west of the intersection; and on the north side of Kiernan Avenue from a point nine hundred twenty feet west of its intersection with Toomes Road, west sixty feet to a point nine hundred eighty feet west of the intersection; and on the north side of Kiernan Avenue from a point one thousand, two hundred forty-five feet west of its intersection with Toomes Road, west sixty feet to a point one thousand, three hundred five feet west of the intersection; and on the north side of Kiernan Avenue from its intersection thereof with Toomes Road east to a point nine hundred feet from the intersection; and on the south side of Kiernan Avenue from its intersection thereof with Toomes Road east to a point one hundred feet from the intersection; and on the south side of Kiernan Avenue from its intersection thereof with Toomes Road west to a point three hundred ten feet from the intersection;”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.



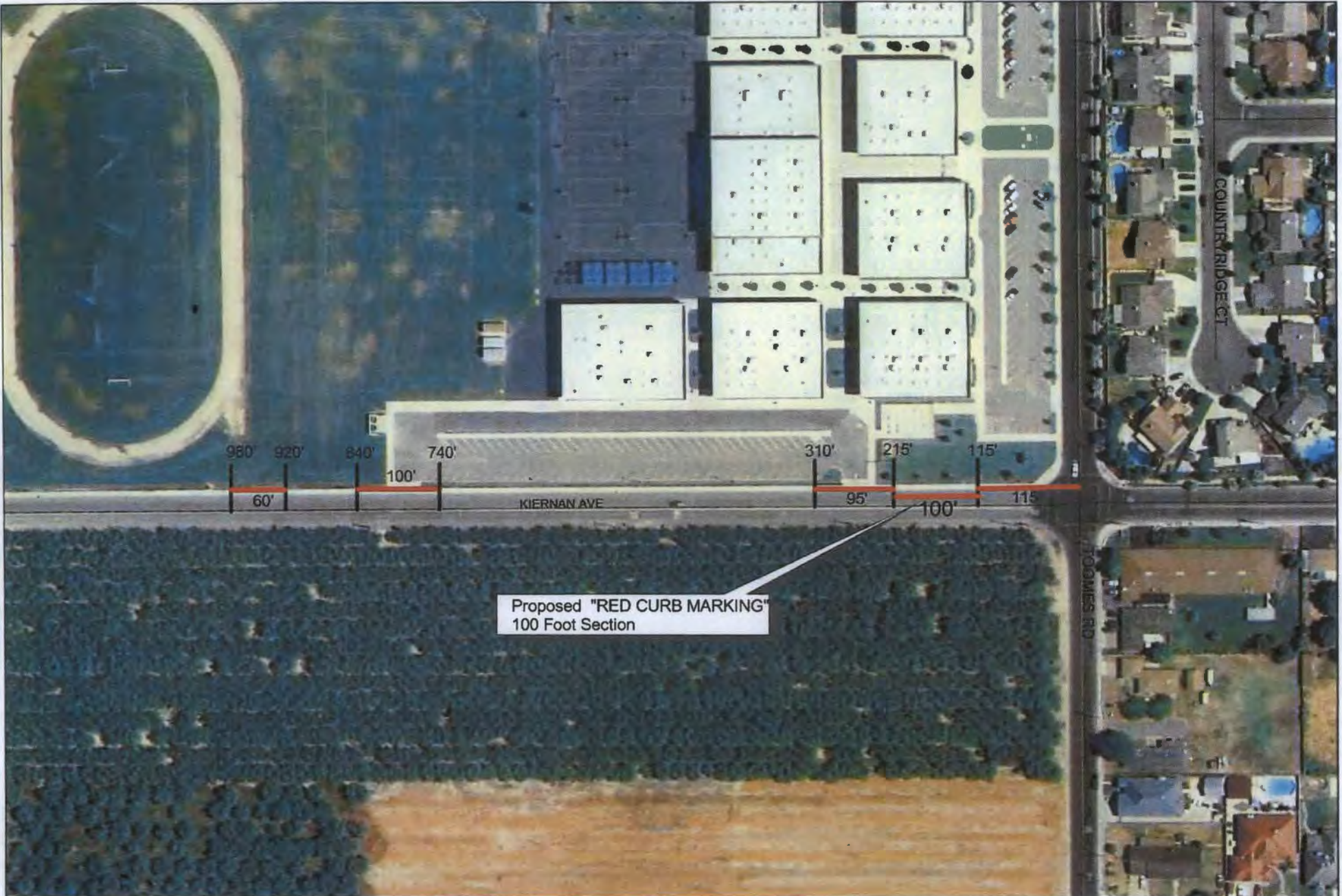

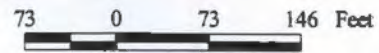
