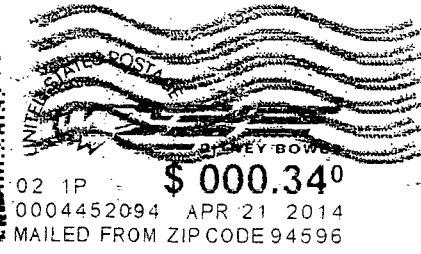


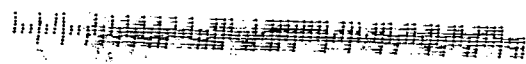

Managing Water in the West

North Valley Regional Recycled Water Program (NVRWP)

SCOPING MEETING

The Bureau of Reclamation and City of Modesto are preparing an Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report for the NVRWP, which would provide recycled water from the Cities of Modesto and Turlock to the Del Puerto Water District via the Delta-Mendota Canal. Recycled water would be conveyed from Modesto and Turlock through pipelines from their water treatment facilities, crossing the San Joaquin River, and ending at the Delta-Mendota Canal. The scoping meeting is designed to solicit your input on topics to be addressed in the environmental document. The meeting will be held on May 13, 2014 from 3:00 to 7:00 pm at:
