Approval to Adopt a Resolution Certifying the Stanislaus County Maintained Road System Mileage

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Adopt a resolution certifying the mileage in Stanislaus County's maintained mileage road system to be 1,510.72 miles as of December 31, 2014.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Maintained mileage is one of the components used in the distribution of Highway Users Tax Account (HUTA) funds. The Fiscal Year 2014-2015 HUTA allocation is \$14.5 million, which is used for general county roadway maintenance and as local funding match for road projects including, signals, bridges, reconstruction, and new road construction.

Approval to Adopt a Resolution Certifying the Stanislaus County Maintained Road System Mileage

DISCUSSION:

Section 2121 of the California Streets and Highways (S&H) Code provides that the County shall submit to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) an inventory of its maintained mileage each year. This inventory includes all additions and exclusions of its mileage of maintained county roads for the previous year. The previous maintained mileage report was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 08, 2014.

The main objective of this activity is to supply the necessary information for distribution of HUTA funds in accordance with Section 2104 of the S&H Code.

The total maintained mileage as of December 31, 2014 is 1,510.72 miles. This is a net decrease of 2.06 miles from the previously reported mileage of 1,512.78 miles as of December 31, 2013.

POLICY ISSUES:

Approval of the maintained mileage is an integral part of Public Works' funding for road maintenance and repair through HUTA fund allocation and supports the Board's priority of A Well Planned Infrastructure System.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE MILEAGE IN STANISLAUS COUNTY'S MAINTAINED ROAD
SYSTEM TO BE 1,510.72 MILES AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2014**

Whereas, Section 2121 of the California Streets and Highway Code provides that each year counties shall submit to the California Department of Transportation the additions to and deletions from their total mileage of maintained county roads; and

Whereas, the California Department of Transportation certified to the State Controller that the total mileage of maintained County roads in the Stanislaus County, as of December 31, 2013, was 1,512.78 miles; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Works has reported that as of December 31, 2014, there was a net decrease of 2.06 miles to the total mileage of maintained County roads during 2014; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Works has also reported that as of December 31, 2014, the total mileage of maintained County roads is 1,510.72 miles.

Now, therefore, it is hereby determined and ordered based on the information provided by the Director of Public Works, that this Board certifies the mileage of County maintained roads as of December 31, 2014 is certified to be 1,510.72 miles.
