

Approval to Proclaim, the Week of May 17, 2015 to May 23, 2015 as Stanislaus County Public Works Week, in Conjunction with National Public Works Week

DISCUSSION:

National Public Works Week is a celebration of the tens of thousands of men and women in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as public works. National Public Works Week is observed each year during the third full week of May.

The Stanislaus County Director of Public Works is asking the Board of Supervisors to proclaim May 17 - 23, 2015 as Stanislaus County Public Works Week. National Public Works Week is about recognizing and thanking our Public Works workforce for the contributions they make every day to the health, safety, comfort, and quality of life to all Stanislaus County residents and visitors.

Stanislaus County Public Works has 106 employees serving the transportation needs of Stanislaus County. Public Works services range from design and construction, encroachment and transportation permits, developing and maintaining Geographic Information System data, parade and special event permits, traffic, transit, mowing, road repairs, street lights, sweeping, tree trimming, weed abatement, and a host of other administrative services.

“Community Begins Here” was selected as the 2015 theme for National Public Works Week by the American Public Works Association. Because of Public Works we are able to have clean water, safe streets and neighborhoods, efficient traffic and safe clean communities.

Recognizing the importance of the services provided by our County Public Works employees and the contributions they make to the community supports the Boards' priorities of A Well Planned Infrastructure and efficient Delivery of Public Services.
