STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the Preliminary Plans and Specifications for the Design of the RSTP Road Resurfacing Program Phase K Project, Federal Project No. STPL-5938(229).
2. Authorize the Public Works Director to Finalize the Plans and Specifications and Advertise the Project for Construction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

An Authorization to Proceed (E-76) has been secured from Caltrans for the design phase of the project in the amount of \$134,825.00. These funds are from the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) and a local match (\$71,900.00 RSTP; \$62,925.00). The E-76 amount is sufficient to cover all County incurred design phase cost. Local match funding is available in the current Fiscal Year Road budget.

Approval to Adopt the Preliminary Plans and Specifications for the Design of the Regional Surface Transportation Program Road Resurfacing Program Phase K Project

DISCUSSION:

The RSTP Road Resurfacing Program Phase K project will consist of Full Depth Reclamation and placing hot mix asphalt concrete overlay onto 9.0 miles of road surfaces creating a smooth, durable, water resistant pavement surface. New striping will be applied on the centerline and edge lines as well as various pavement markings. Shoulder backing will be placed to stabilize the shoulders. Adjustments in pavement traffic signal loops, utilities and monuments will be included.

The following roads are included in the RSTP Road Resurfacing Program Phase K project:

1. Milnes Road from Albers Road to Oakdale-Waterford Highway.
2. Claribel Road from Albers Road to Oakdale-Waterford Highway.
3. Howard Road from Frank Cox Road to McCracken Road.
4. Faith Home Road from West Main Street to Levine Road.

All preliminary engineering was done in-house by County staff. Construction of the proposed project is planned to commence in summer of 2015.

Stanislaus County is the lead agency for CEQA and the project is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act, Class I, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15301 (Existing Facilities) and §15302 (Replace and Reconstruction).

POLICY ISSUES:

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Safe Community, A Healthy Community and A Well Planned Infrastructure System by improving traffic safety and flow in this area of Stanislaus County.
