3. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment A, to add services and payment for services up to \$75,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout the Fiscal Year 2015-2016.
4. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment B, to add services and payment for services up to \$25,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout the Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

**DISCUSSION:**

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services contracts with numerous individuals and agencies for the provision of mental health, alcohol and other drug, and ancillary services to Stanislaus County residents. In most cases, individuals and agencies are selected through a competitive process, which takes into account specific expertise, as well as cost efficiency. Agreements are renewed based on a demonstrated ability to deliver required outcomes effectively, along with availability of funding. While a number of agencies have successful, long term partnering relationships with Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, all applicable provider agreements will continue to be reviewed and competitive bids will be sought periodically, consistent with Board of Supervisors' direction.

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services experiences occasional funding opportunities and unanticipated increases in the utilization of services throughout the year. On many occasions, this additional funding is time sensitive. For this reason, the Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$75,000 to the agreements listed in Attachment A of this agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

Attachment A includes those agreements that have a cumulative value that exceeds \$100,000, for the period beginning July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016, as required in Contract Reporting Policy Number One, originally approved by the Board on January 24, 2006 and modified by the Board on March 22, 2011.

*"Departments are required to obtain approval by the Board of Supervisors for any contract or agreement where the total cumulative compensation exceeds \$100,000. For purposes of this policy, cumulative refers to the total compensation paid by an individual department in the reporting year and the two fiscal years immediately prior thereto, where there has been no break in contractual services over 6 months."*

Approval of Agreements for Behavioral Health & Recovery Services for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for the Provision of Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug, and Ancillary Services

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Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

In addition, County departments are required to provide a quarterly report to the Board of Supervisors for any agreement entered into, where the compensation exceeds \$50,000 but does not exceed \$100,000, and the contract has not been previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. Attachment B identifies these agreements.

The Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$25,000 to all agreements listed in Attachment B of this agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2015-2016. Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

The total amount of contracts over \$100,000 cumulatively, to be approved by the Board of Supervisors through this agenda item is \$31,079,366 for Fiscal Year 2015-2016. The total amount of contracts over \$50,000 cumulatively but under \$100,000 over this time period is \$375,600. The total for all proposed agreements is \$31,454,966. It is essential that the agreements in this agenda item be fully executed before July 1, 2015 to avoid disruption of critical services to the residents of Stanislaus County.

**POLICY ISSUE:**

Approval of this agenda item supports the Board of Supervisors' priorities of A Healthy Community, Effective Partnerships and Efficient Delivery of Public Services by contracting with community providers to deliver needed services at an appropriate level of care in a cost effective manner.

**STAFFING IMPACT:**

Existing staff from Behavioral Health and Recovery Services are available to support these agreements including any necessary monitoring, amending and reporting.
