NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0088

COUNTY: Stanislaus

STREAM SYSTEM: San Joaquin River

The City of Turlock (Petitioner) filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The Petitioner seeks authorization to cease its current discharge of treated wastewater to the San Joaquin River during all months of the year. The Petitioner also proposes to transfer up to 26,904 acre-feet per year of treated wastewater to Del Puerto Water District for irrigation use and to several wildlife refuges for fish and wildlife enhancement.
