Pursuant to President Obama's major disaster declaration of September 22, 2015, and Amendment No. 3 dated September 23, 2015 (FEMA-4240-DR-CA), the U.S. Small Business Administration has declared the primary counties of **Calaveras** and **Lake** a disaster area.
