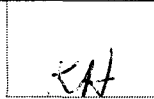

DISCUSSION:

Historically, the month of March has been declared as Social Work Month. We ask the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors to declare March 2016 as Social Work Month in Stanislaus County to recognize the following:

- Social Work Month was initiated in 1962 by the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) as a time to honor the Social Work profession.
- Social Work is a specialized field in helping children, adults and families in need. Social Workers provide assistance in improving relationships, promoting self-sufficiency, creating safer environments, accessing resources, supporting vulnerable populations and promoting social, emotional, and mental health.
- Social Workers provide services throughout our community, including behavioral health settings, hospitals, schools, foster family and adoption agencies, corrections, community organizations, child welfare, adult protective services, in-home supportive services, and family violence centers.
- Social Workers throughout Stanislaus County have successfully engaged and strengthened families to build a safer and stronger community. As a result of their practice, many families have increased their resiliency with better ways to cope with internal and external stressors, developed healthier relationships within the family and with their social connections, increased their knowledge of parenting as well as meeting the medical, emotional, social, and developmental needs of their children and gained knowledge of the different support systems in the community.
