MEMBERSHIP: The Commission consists of twenty-one (21) members. (The Act
QUALIFICATION: requires at least fifty-one percent of the members to be 60+ years
AND RESIDENCY of age.)
REQUIREMENTS: **10 members appointed by the Board of Supervisors (2 from each Supervisorial District)**
11 members appointed by Commission membership:
1 Disabled Representative
1 Minority Representative
1 Elected Official Representative
1 Service Provider Representative
7 Public Members-at-Large

TERM: 3 Year Term with two term limitation

DUTIES: The Commission works as an advocate on behalf of the Stanislaus county senior community. The Commission is responsible for advising the Area Agency on Aging and the Board of Supervisors on services and issues pertaining to senior citizens.
