TERM: Voting members serve for a term of four years, not more than 2 terms.

*Communicate the uses and benefits of the Commission to the community at large.
*Encourage use of Commission services by the community and citizens in Stanislaus County.
*Coordinate with the County Board of Supervisors and the Board of Directors of the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office and the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office.
