LEGAL AUTHORITY: Board of Supervisors Resolution #2003-1166

MEMBERSHIP: The Board consists of three (3) hearing officers appointed by the Board of Supervisors, who will rotate monthly in conducting Animal Court.
QUALIFICATION: Each hearing officer must be an active member of the California State Bar in good standing and in active practice for the last five years before
AND RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: appointment

TERM: Terms shall be for two years; may be renewed after performance review.

DUTIES: To hold public administrative hearings & render decisions for violations to County Code Chapter 7 as the violations relate to animal breeding, care, licensing, well-being, control, and potentially dangerous/vicious dogs. Neither misdemeanor nor felony citations will be heard by Animal Court.
