LEGAL AUTHORITY: Board of Supervisors Resolution #70-377
& Welfare & Institution Code 4543-4570

MEMBERSHIP: The Board has fifteen (15) members, 2 of whom are **appointed** by the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors:

QUALIFICATION: 2 Representatives of Stanislaus County

AND RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: 2 Representatives of Amador County

2 Representatives of Calaveras County

2 Representatives of San Joaquin County

2 Representatives of Tuolumne County

5 Representatives appointed by the Governor of California

Appointees shall include:

a) Persons with developmental disabilities, the parents, guardians, or conservators of such persons – 50%, and

b) Representatives of the general public – 50%

TERM AND DUTIES: 3 Year Term with two term limitation.

The responsibilities of the Board include:

- 1) Protecting and speaking out for the rights of people with developmental disabilities;
- 2) Identifying and resolving problems that persons with developmental disabilities have in receiving the services they need;
- 3) Checking to see that public agencies are providing the services the law requires them to provide; and
- 4) Improving the quality of life of persons with developmental disabilities by helping to develop services that promote independence and productivity.
