Code §51222; finds the lot line adjustment would not compromise the long-term agricultural productivity of the parcel or other agricultural lands subject to a contract or contracts; finds the lot line adjustment is not likely to result in the removal of adjacent land from agricultural use; finds the lot line adjustment does not result in a greater number of developable parcels than existed prior to the adjustment, or an adjusted lot that is inconsistent with the General Plan - Planning
