PROJECT TITLE: Turlock Area - Measure L Sidewalk Project

PROJECT LOCATION: Stanislaus County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed project would upgrade sections of pedestrian facilities including replacement of curb, and gutter and paving of unpaved pedestrian walkways along the east side of West Avenue, between Jordan Avenue and South Avenue; along an approximately 670-foot section of the north side of Linwood Avenue, extending west from its intersection with Lander Avenue; and along an approximately 530-foot section of the west side of Lander Avenue, extending north from Linwood Avenue. Project work would connect to existing paved sidewalk facilities and maintain driveway accesses and utility lines within the project footprint.

Location: Approximately 0.61 mile span of Las Palmas Avenue between Highway 33 to the east end of the City limit

Description: This project consists of a pavement overlay incorporating recycled asphalt. The project site is located along Las Palmas Avenue from Highway 33 to the east end of the City limit in the Patterson, California. The road segment where construction will occur spans approximately 0.61 mile. Prior to overlaying, pavement surface with severe conditions will be excavated and reconstructed with aggregate base and asphalt concrete. The existing road will be cold planed where tying into the existing road sections and along existing gutter sections. All existing striping, markings, and markers shall be removed in preparation of an overlay, disposed of in accordance with regulations, and replaced with thermoplastic striping, markings, and reflective markers after the completion of an overlay. All existing manhole and valve covers are required to be raised to the final grade. In addition, all crosswalks within the project area shall be reconstructed to meet the most current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Standards. This is an effort to maintaining and improving roadway safety within the City of Patterson.

With the exception of the California State Route 33 and the railroad that both intersect Las Palmas Avenue, all improvements are located within the City of Patterson right-of-way.

Location: At the intersection of Salado Avenue and 7th Street

Description: This project proposes Traffic Management Intersection Improvements at Salado Ave and 7th street. It involves construction of a roundabout to ease congestion and pedestrian traffic. Under existing conditions this five-leg intersection is all-way stop controlled. Converting the intersection into a roundabout would improve operations to Level of Service (LOS) A, reducing the number of stops drivers make, improving traffic efficiency, and reducing missions. The study intersection is located next to Patterson High School and the existing pedestrian facilities are not consistent with current Caltrans Standards. This project would upgrade the pedestrian crosswalks to high visibility yellow crosswalks which are appropriate in a school zone. It would also modify the angle of the crosswalks to be oriented 90 degrees relative to the direction of travel, improving both driver and pedestrian awareness and visibility. Pedestrian traffic and business/school access are critical along these streets during the normal work-week and these issues should be addressed during the design and construction process.
