NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION


Notice is hereby given that the Stanislaus County Department of Parks and Recreation has prepared an Initial Study (IS) of environmental effects and intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the Woodward Reservoir North Shore Event Venue project. The Stanislaus County is the Lead Agency for this project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The proposed project includes access and other improvements required to accommodate multi-day festival and other events of up to 30,000 attendees. Future development of public camping and day use facilities will be discussed in future CEQA studies. A detailed project description is provided in Chapter 2.0 of the Initial Study.

The IS/MND analyzed the potential environmental effects of the project in the environmental issue areas specified in CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines. On the basis of this analysis, the IS/MND finds that the project will not involve any significant environmental effects, provided that the mitigation measures described in the IS/MND are implemented. The County has agreed to the mitigation measures, and these measures will be included in a Mitigation Monitoring/Reporting Plan to be adopted by the County in conjunction with adoption of the IS/MND and approval of the project. There are no sites identified under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code located on or near the project site.

Copies of the IS/MND are available for public review at the Department of Parks and Recreation at the address shown above, at the Stanislaus County Library at 1500 "I" Street, Modesto, at the Oakdale branch library at 151 South 1st Street, Oakdale and at the Department of Parks and Recreation website: <http://www.stancounty.com/parks/>. The County will accept public and agency comments on the IS/MND during a 30-day review period that will begin on July 19, 2019 and end on August 19, 2019. Comments may be submitted by mail to the address shown above or by email to wnewlin@envres.org.

In addition, the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of the IS/MND and the Mitigation Monitoring/Reporting Plan for the project at a public meeting to be scheduled following the public review period.
