The Stanislaus County Public Works Department (County) has prepared an Initial Study (IS) of environmental effects and intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the Golden State Boulevard/Golf Road/Berkeley Avenue Intersection Project in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State CEQA Guidelines. The County is the lead agency for the proposed project under CEQA. The County proposes to construct operational improvements at the Golden State Boulevard/Golf Road/Berkeley Avenue Intersection (Project). The Project site is located south of the City of Turlock in the southern portion of the County. Land uses surrounding the Project site consist of agricultural with adjacent open space, commercial, industrial, and urban transitional uses.

The County has prepared a draft Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) and it is now available for a 30-day public review and comment period. The recommended finding is that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment with implementation of Board-approved environmental mitigation measures.


Comments should be focused on the sufficiency of the document in disclosing the potential environmental effects from the project and the proposed mitigation measures.
