The project is a renovation of the existing César E. Chavez Park that will include the development of a new lighted splash park/aquatic center, new multi-purpose rooms, lighted picnic pavilion, basketball court, skate plaza, walking paths, outdoor fitness stations, youth soccer field, stage, restroom building, bioswales, raingarden, park security lighting, landscaping, irrigation and various site amenities.
