NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Patterson Irrigation District has prepared an Initial Study and proposes to adopt a Negative Declaration (ND) for the project referred to as the "Marshall Reservoir Pump Station." The project is located on land in western Stanislaus County owned by the Patterson Irrigation District.

The proposed project involves the construction of a reinforced concrete pump sump and manifold, relocation of two pumps, the installation of approximately 400 feet of 30" PVC pipe and the construction of approximately 900 feet of barrier (likely sheetpile) within the Marshall Reservoir. This water conveyance facility will recirculate approximately 7000 acre feet per year of agricultural drain water into the Patterson Irrigation District water conveyance system.

As mandated by law, the minimum public review period for the document is 30 days. The document is available for review online at the Patterson Irrigation District website (<https://www.pattersonid.org/>). A public hearing has been scheduled on July 15, 2020 at 1:00 pm. The Public Review Period will close July 15, 2020.
