Opportunities for Comment

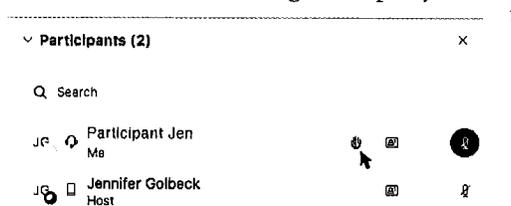
Members of the public or community based organizations will be able to provide comment to the Low Income Oversight Board during Agenda Items 2 & 4, or if requested by the Board.

Members of the board are not allowed to take any formal action on an item not on the agenda. If possible, it is requested that public comment be limited to 2 minutes per speaker.

To comment verbally during the meeting, please use the “Raise Hand” feature of Webex:

1. Locate your name on the participant list, and hover over your name. A Hand icon will appear.
2. Click on the Raise Hand button which will place a small hand icon next to your name in the participant list. Your raised hand will only be visible to the Host.
3. When the Host calls your name to invite you to speak, please unmute yourself and provide comment.
