**LA GRANGE REGIONAL PARK**  
**FACILITIES OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS (FO&M)**  
**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**  
**OHV LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS OR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS**

Stanislaus County is set aside from most other Counties within the State of California due to the fact that the County owns and operates not one, but two Off-Highway Vehicle Parks totaling 2,000 acres of available and dedicated land for all types of Off-Road Adventures for County residents and visitors alike. Our OHV visitors consist of Stanislaus County and we routinely have visitors from the Bay Area, Sacramento, Fresno, and the Sierra Foothills. Both parks, La Grange and Frank Raines are open to all registered and CVC compliant vehicles such as: 4WD, ATV's, Sand-Rails, Motorcycles and buggies to name a few.

***La Grange Regional Off-Highway Vehicle Park*** is located at 2315 South Old La Grange Road, LaGrange, California (approximately 18 miles east of Waterford, 30 miles northeast of Merced, and 30 miles southwest of Jamestown on Route J59.) This Park offers undeveloped camping, restrooms, a parking lot and approximately 150 acres of land open to recreational riding. The resources are in fair condition considering the prior use of land (quarry) before it became an OHV Park. The trails are rated for beginners with stock OHV's to intermediate riders, as well as a motocross style course and dedicated under 90cc track for our younger beginners. La Grange OHV Park is open year around Off-Road.

This grant application is for a Facilities Operation and Maintenance grant (*FO&M*) for La Grange OHV Park. The grant would help keep the park in operation for the motocross races that take place at the park. It would also assist the County in meeting the needs of users who frequent the park on weekends or holidays. The grant funds would assist the County in servicing the facility in the following areas:

With the operational funding for a Park Maintenance Worker II and one part-time Park Aide, the County will be able to provide a greater level of service to our constituents that use the facility. The County staff will be available to assure a

clean, well-groomed, and positive recreational experience for our OHV users by keeping the bathrooms clean and grading the motor cross track. Should significant changes in the terrain or environment develop, staff will be present to assess and address these important issues. Without operational funding, staff presence will be reduced and only available during the peak season. The current peak season for this park is roughly from October 15 through April 15. With our present staff, we are able to grade the track monthly for scheduled motocross races during the peak season. On the off-season, the park is maintained sporadically. When the season resumes there is additional maintenance that needs to be planned due to the time the park was neglected due to a shortage of labor and funds.

There is presently a well at the park, which besides being used for the maintenance of the track, also waters the trees, and provides irrigation for ground cover adjacent to the track. The County received an OHV grant that paid for the electrical source for the well, pumps, water lines, water tanks, and associated needs to complete the water system. Due to the location of the well, a fence was constructed to protect the holding tanks, since the location of the area is so remote.

The water tank currently holds 10,000-gallons of water to be used primarily for grooming the motocross track at the La Grange OHV Park. Due to the booking of races, the County has committed to increasing the water tanks to a maximum of 50,000 gallons. This should be more than enough to meet the current need at La Grange for Motocross racing. On August 1, 2007 the County received a letter from the California Motorcycle Association (CMA) requesting an agreement that would allow them to utilize the track on a regular basis. The letter stated, "In past seasons we have seen enthusiasm from our participants and potential for long term use." The County will be considering their proposal.

Visitors who go to the La Grange OHV area will meet challenges like soft sandy soil, water hazards, and hill climbs. There was a recent addition of an intermediate track for users between the ages of ten and fifteen years old. The user of the park can expect to enjoy groomed trails, groomed competitive tracks, camping, restrooms, benches, shade trees, and barbeques.

The groups who enjoy the park are the Over the Hill Gang, Modesto 4-wheel drive, California Motor Cross Association, East Bay High Tailers, American Motocross Promotions, Mutant Motor Sports, A.M.P. Racing, Merced Dirt Riders, and CORVA. The types of vehicles used here are dune buggies, motorcycles and ATV's and miscellaneous 4 wheel drives.

The volunteer program with the Modesto Ridge runners and the County is still active. The Modesto Ridge runners have volunteered time to accomplish litter and debris removal and help install water lines for tree irrigation. They are also responsible for graffiti removal at the site.

Partnerships with CMA and Mutant Motorsports for motocross events have also helped bring awareness of the recreational opportunities at La Grange OHV Park. As part of the race promoters' responsibility, the motocross track is groomed before each event. Attendance has been excellent at the events held this past season. Each event draws in approximately 200-500 hundred riders and at least as many spectators.

The Facility and Operations grant will give us the opportunity to offer the public additional coverage at the park to maintain the recreational facility as well as to answer any questions or address any problems that might arise. With the assistance of the OHMVR grant, Stanislaus County will be able to improve amenities like the parking lot, add additional concrete tables, additional portable toilets, and replacement of the existing in ground fire rings/barbeque grills. The grant would help to keep the park looking its best, not just for the scheduled races but also year-round for the avid users of the park.

La Grange Off-Highway Vehicle Park

From 2006 through 2007 is the grant we are currently working on and our accomplishments are as follows:

1. **Replacing the trash cans at the La Grange OHV park:** A plan is in place to purchase approximately 40-50 garbage cans and have them replaced at the OHV site.
2. **Improving safety at the park:** There was 500 feet of field fencing installed that helped to slow down riders especially in congested traffic areas.
3. **Improved the riding conditions at the Novice Track:** Added soil to the Novice Track to improve riding conditions.
4. **Added Intermediate Track:** Added an additional track for users utilizing motorcycles. (200 ccs and below)
5. **Installed no climb fencing** for protection of private property.
6. **Installed fencing on the south side** of the racetrack to provide better public use during racing events.
