

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code, Division 20, Chapter 6.95, Section 25535.2, and California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Division 2, Chapter 4.5, Section 2745.2(c) facilities that handle regulated substances above certain thresholds are required to prepare risk management plans. The goal of a risk management program is to prevent chemical accidents that could cause harm to the public and the environment and to reduce the potential impact of accidental releases. The risk management plan contains an off-site consequence analysis that evaluates specific potential release scenarios including worst-case and alternative scenarios; a history of accidental releases; an integrated prevention program to manage risk; an emergency response program; and a management system to oversee the implementation of the risk management program. The risk management plans for the following facilities are available for public review and comment at the Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources, 3800 Cornucopia Way, Suite C, and Stanislaus County Environmental Resources website under Hazardous Materials Division until **June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.
