Hard-to-Handle (Bulk Material): RV trailers, mobile homes, dead animals (except horses, llamas, mules, donkeys), large plastic sheets, wire, bailing twine, tree stumps/logs & whole trees, treated wood waste, non-friable asbestos, large tanks, long/large pipe (over 4 feet), large chunks of concrete <i>over 2'x2'x2'</i> , boats, pontoons, large sheets of foam or aluminum siding, sensitive records, spoiled/damaged finished food products, and all other material in pieces over 4'x4' <i>x4'</i> . Must call ahead to arrange an appointment. Tuesday - Friday ONLY, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. *Large loads of dead animals require a written request from the Director of the Office of Emergency Services. **Price is per dead animal or \$100/ton whichever is greater.
