This notice is an invitation to attend a public meeting to discuss proposed new and amended or elimination of existing fees to the Stanislaus County Master Schedule of Fees for the Department of Environmental Resources (DER). The mission of DER is to promote a safe and healthy environment and improve the quality of life in our community. To achieve and maintain an appropriate level of protection, DER recognizes that it is necessary to have collaboration with the County's business community. It is the hope of this Department that you would make every effort to attend the upcoming workshop. Your input and expertise are valuable to our community to ensure that we accomplish this goal.

This workshop is being conducted prior to the Board of Supervisors' approval of the fee proposals. The proposed fee adjustments will be available online by the date of the workshop, at <http://www.stancounty.com/er/>. Please let us know if you would like a copy emailed, mailed or faxed to you.

Please join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. This includes adjustments related to the Department's Weighted Labor Rate, as well as, new and amended or elimination of existing fees related to:

- **Hazardous Materials - Underground Storage Tank and Hazardous Waste Generator Program fees**
- **Environmental Health - Food Categories 1, 2, 3, Temporary and Mobile Food Facilities, Cottage Food Operations, Body Art Program, Recreational Health Facilities, Public Water Systems, Well Destruction/Installation Without a Valid Permit, Septic Pumper Trucks, Liquid Waste Program, Land Use Program, and Administrative fees, as well as, adding new fee categories, including but not limited to new Massage Establishment fees, and eliminating some fee categories**
- **Milk and Dairy - Grade A and B, including Other Hooved Mammals, quarterly fees**
- **Landfill - Price by Load, Normal Refuse, Ash Tipping, Special Handling, and Hard-to-Handle fees**

If the fees are approved, they will become effective 30 days after passage, on June 19, 2020, with the exception of changes to any Landfill fees which would become effective on July 1, 2020.
