Please join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. This includes new and amended fees related to:

- **Environmental Health - Food Categories 1, 2, 3, Mobile Food Facilities, Public Water Systems, Well Construction Permits, and Liquid Waste Fees, as well as, adding new fee categories and eliminating some fee categories**
- **Hazardous Materials - Underground Storage Tank and Aboveground Petroleum Storage Tank Fees and new CalARP Program Fees**
- **Landfill - Price by Load, Normal Refuse, Ash Tipping, Non-Friable Asbestos, Special Handling, Hard-to-Handle, and Dead Animals Fees, as well as, adding a new Uncovered Load Fee and a new Reloading Fee**

If the fees are approved, they will become effective 30 days after passage, on June 21, 2019, with the exception of changes to any Landfill fees which would become effective on July 1, 2019.
