<b>VISION AND MISSION</b>	<p>Our vision is to continue to be a leader in behavioral health and to be recognized for excellence in our community, state, and nation. In partnership with our community, our mission is to provide and manage effective promotion and behavioral health services that promote wellness, resilience, and recovery.</p>			
<b>OVERVIEW OF SERVICES</b>	<p>Behavioral Health and Recovery Services provides services to individuals with serious and persistent mental illness and/or alcohol or other drug abuse or addiction.</p> <p>Rehabilitation and recovery services are provided to those who have difficulty maintaining stable residence, significant inability to engage in productive activities and daily responsibilities, or experience frequent or lengthy psychiatric hospitalization. Services include case management, medication services, brief individual therapy, group therapy, specialized services for dually diagnosed clients (concurrent mental illness and substance abuse), assistance in obtaining training for employment and education, assistance in obtaining housing, peer support, peer directed activities and groups, family support and educational and recovery groups for clients and family members.</p> <p>Treatment and recovery services are provided for those with an alcohol and/or other drug addiction. These services include group counseling, family support and education, referral for residential treatment and aftercare services.</p> <p><b>Public Guardian services include conservatorship investigation and administration.</b></p>			
<b>STAFF</b>	<p>The organization employs 457 full time staff and 109 part time staff. This represents psychiatrists, psychiatric nurses, mental health clinicians, behavioral health specialists, clinical staff technicians, administrative clerks, accountants, data management technicians and other support staff.</p>			
<b>BUDGET</b>	<p>The \$84,558,747 budget represents funding from the State Departments of Mental Health and Alcohol &amp; Drug Programs, Stanislaus County general fund, grants, and some specialized Federal funding.</p>			
<b>LOCATIONS</b>	<p>Services are provided in the following towns: Ceres, Turlock, Oakdale, Patterson, and Modesto. In addition, Some specialized services are co-located with other programs/agencies throughout Stanislaus County.</p>
