

The Health Services Agency

The Stanislaus County Health Services Agency (HSA) has provided healthcare to the residents of Stanislaus County since 1891. HSA holds strongly its vision of “Healthy People in a Healthy Stanislaus!” by developing its services with the community, in ways that support community needs.

The Agency is an outpatient and public health system, serving 500,000 patients and clients each year. At present, the HSA provides service through: outpatient medical offices in multiple locations throughout the county: the Public Health Department; the Women, Infant and Children (WIC) Program; Valley Family Medicine Residency Program, Indigent Health Care Program, health promotion and wellness programs, and in collaboration with Medi-Cal Managed Care licensed health care service plans.
