

The Health Services Agency

The Stanislaus County Health Services Agency (HSA) has provided healthcare to the residents of Stanislaus County since 1891. HSA holds strongly its vision of “Leading the Way to a Healthy Community”, by developing its services with the community, in ways that support community needs.

The Agency is an outpatient and public health system, serving nearly 500,000 patients and clients each year. At present, the HSA provides service through: outpatient medical offices in seven locations throughout the county; the Public Health Department; the Women, Infant and Children (WIC) Program; Stanislaus Family Practice Residency Program, Indigent Health Care Program, health promotion and wellness programs, and a Medi-Cal insurance product operated in partnership with Blue Cross of California.

HSA employs over 800 staff members, and has a group of dedicated volunteers. HSA’s main campus is located at 830 Scenic Drive in Modesto, where the following services are provided:

- Public Health Department - communicable diseases, outreach programs, immunization services, sexually transmitted disease testing (STDs) and public health laboratory.
- Family Practice Center - a primary care medical office, including residency teaching, serving over 40,000 patients each year.
- Urgent Care Center - 9:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. serving over 20,000 patients each year.
- Specialty Clinics - physician clinics with specialties including oncology, cardiology, GI Lab, neurology, orthopedics, pain management, dermatology, ENT, surgery, podiatry and urology.
- California Children's Services - The goal of CCS is to locate California children who may need specialized medical care and encourage families with children with physical disabilities to obtain necessary medical services to maximize their children's potential.
- Ancillary Services - Radiology, laboratory, microbiology lab, nuclear medicine, pharmacy, physical therapy, speech therapy and occupational therapy.

In addition, HSA operates the following medical offices throughout the County: Medical Arts Building, Paradise Medical Office, McHenry Medical Office, Ceres Medical Office, Hughson Medical Office, and Turlock Medical Office.

The main WIC office is located in the Community Services Agency on Hackett Road, with other offices in Ceres, Turlock, Patterson, Riverbank, Hughson, Oakdale, and Waterford.
