Arizona Sheriff's Department Arrest Suspect in 13 Year-Old Modesto Homicide Case

MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA-Officers from the Gila River Indian Police Department arrested Jose Luis OSEGUERA 03/14/1971 who was wanted for a homicide that occurred on August 28, 1994. Detectives believe OSEGUERA shot and killed Hazael Diaz Luengas in the 1600 block of Imperial after some type of argument.

OSEGUERA was arrested after officer responded to Gila River Vee Quiva Casino for an intoxicated person. After checking OSEGUERA for warrants, officers found an arrest warrant for homicide from Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department. OSEGUERA was arrested and booked into the county jail, but was able to bail out before Stanislaus County officials could confirm the arrest warrant. Today, the arrest warrant was confirmed and OSEGUERA was located and arrested. He is currently being held in a Maricopa County Jail while arrangements are being made to bring him back to California.
