Library card holders have access to thousands of books, books on tape/cd, classic movies and educational videos and DVDs, magazines and newspapers. More than 140 computers are available for public Internet use and word processing at libraries throughout the county. Small group computer classes are offered at many libraries. ReadingWorks Adult Literacy students and tutors meet at libraries to help people improve their reading and writing skills.

The library is also a wonderful place for children to learn and explore. All branches of the Stanislaus County Library offer weekly StoryTimes and special children's programs. Students can find reliable information at the library, in print and through premium online services. College-bound students will find information on colleges, scholarships and financial aid, as well as a video collection of 124 top-rated colleges.

At www.stanislauslibrary.org customers can search the library catalog and access their library card accounts, chat with a reference librarian 24 hours a day and apply for a library card online. Premium online content, available only to library cardholders, includes magazine articles, car repair manuals for specific makes and models, biographies, position papers and literary essays about authors and their works. Customers can even download popular audiobooks through a free checkout.
