### **Three Arrested Following Gang Related Drive-By Shooting Murder Investigation**

Modesto – On Wednesday, 7-29-09 at 6:11 P.M., Stanislaus County Sheriff's deputies responded to 601 Broadway Ave., Modesto, CA regarding reports of shots fired in front of the residence. Deputies arrived and found Alberto Schopp, a 23-year old Modesto, CA resident, laying in the street dead from an apparent gunshot wound. Witnesses at the scene were able to give deputies a vehicle description of the suspect vehicle.

Schopp was positively identified and his family has been notified.

In the early morning hours on Thursday, 7-30-09, detectives tracked down the suspect vehicle to a Ceres, CA., address. Detectives took a juvenile male into custody in connection with the drive-by shooting. The 17-year old juvenile was booked into juvenile hall for murder. Later in the morning, detectives arrested Ulises Carenas Sanchez, 6-28-90, in west Modesto, CA. Detectives later booked him for murder in connection with the drive-by shooting.

Later in the day, detectives found the third suspect located at 628 Alturas in Modesto, CA. The Stanislaus County Sheriff's SWAT team arrested Rafael Lopez-Camacho, 10-4-86, and he was later booked for murder in connection with the drive-by shooting.

Detectives believe they have everyone they are looking in-custody for this murder. Anyone having any information about this investigation can call Detective Ken Hedrick at (209) 525-7083.
