Sheriff's Office Arrests Two Men for Vehicle Burglary, Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Criminal Conspiracy

Modesto, CA – Travis Holsapple 31 of Modesto, CA and Juan Carlos Hernandez 24 of Modesto, CA were arrested this afternoon for vehicle burglary, assault with a deadly weapon and criminal conspiracy. The charges stemmed from a vehicle burglary investigation earlier in the morning.

At 7:30 AM Sheriff's deputies and CHP officers responded to the 2600 Block of Ustick Rd in Modesto, CA for a reported vehicle burglary. Two male suspects had broken into a cargo truck parked on the side of Ustick Rd. When the owner of the cargo truck and a family member returned to pick up the cargo truck they found two male suspects breaking into it.

The two suspects fled in their vehicle when they were interrupted and struck one of the family members during their escape. The family member was dragged by the car and was later transported to the emergency room for treatment major injuries.

Sheriff's deputies and investigators began to look for the suspect's car and were able to find it in the 1700 Block of Olympia. Holsapple and Hernandez were identified and arrested for vehicle burglary, assault with a deadly weapon and criminal conspiracy.
