Family Law Classes at the Modesto Library

The Modesto Library is hosting a series of informational classes presented by the attorneys at Cash-Dudley, Speiller, and Torres. The classes will be held every other Saturday in June, beginning on June 2, with each presentation featuring a different topic related to family law. Those who would like to learn more about family law will find it beneficial to talk to lawyers at these free presentations. The Family Law Classes at the Modesto Library are:

- Child Custody and Visitation.....Saturday, June 2, 12 p.m.
In this two-hour session, participants will learn the procedures in the Stanislaus County Superior Court system to obtain a child custody and visitation order.
- Grandparent RightsSaturday, June 16, 12 p.m.
This two-hour session will cover the legal rights of grandparents in California, including the removal of grandparents’ rights by the Supreme Court and the subsequent court cases restoring some of those rights.
- Rights of Unmarried Parties in Family LawSaturday, June 30, 12 p.m.
This two-hour session will cover the legal rights of unmarried parties in family law. This includes individuals who have property in joint names and/or have children together.
