### Free Instructional Programs at the Modesto Library

The Modesto Library will offer free instructional programs this January, including an informational program on taxes and a résumé writing workshop.

A representative from H&R Block will present "Taxes, the Affordable Care Act, and You" on Jan. 7 at 4 p.m. This program will cover how the Affordable Care Act applies to taxes, penalties, tax credits, and tax exemptions. Some taxpayers may be required to use a new tax form. Participants will learn what is required for their particular tax situation.

Résumé Expert, Roberta "Bobbi" Scherrer will lead a free Résumé Workshop on Jan. 21 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Scherrer will take participants through the basics of résumé writing, including how to tailor a résumé to a desired job or industry. Participants must bring a completed résumé worksheet, available at the Modesto Library Reference Desk or online at [www.stanislauslibrary.org](http://www.stanislauslibrary.org). Following a lunch break, Scherrer will assist participants with résumé creation using the library's computers, or personal laptops, starting at 1 p.m. A working knowledge of computers and/or keyboarding is required for this portion of the workshop and participants should bring their own flash drives to save any work.
