## Community Meetings on Laura's Law

### Meeting objective:

- Laura's Law, also referred to as "Assisted Outpatient Treatment" (AOT), has been an optional service which California counties may choose to implement with local funding.
- Participating counties are required to provide prescribed assisted outpatient services that are client directed and employ psychosocial rehabilitation and recovery principles.
- Eligible individuals are those who suffer from severe mental illness, and repeatedly get arrested or hospitalized due to their failure to stay in treatment and are court ordered to engage in AOT.

These forums are for fact finding and informational purposes to fully evaluate and develop a summary of feedback and recommendations that can be used to formulate a policy recommendation for Stanislaus County leadership and the Board of Supervisors to consider as to whether or not to adopt Laura's Law as a service option in Stanislaus County.
