3. Mural Policy: County Counsel had addressed a concern with a County Code that prohibits any advertisement on such displays as murals. The ordinance specifically states: "painting, marking, pasting, fastening any bill, advertisement, inscription, or graffiti on any tree, fence, wall, building monument or other property in a recreation area, except on bulletin boards specifically provided for this, is not permitted." (Stanislaus County Code 18.06.020 Post no bills.) Given this fact, the Department recommended striking out criteria nine off the policy. In discussion of commemorating the artwork, the Commission moved to support the proposed changes as recommended. The Department plans to bring this item to the Board on April 23, 2013.

4. Empire Pool: The Empire Pool Committee is hosting a fundraiser event for the pool on June 9th, 2013. The event will be held at the Modesto airport. PAL will be selling tickets. The goal is to secure funds for the next five years. Five groups are currently being identified to help fulfill this goal each year. PAL is looking forward to being one of the five of the group to support operations of the pool beginning FY 2014-2015. CPRS District IV is hosting a lifeguard training on June 9th at the Johansen High School pool, which will be \$75 per agency with unlimited lifeguard trainees.

CIP: The Capital Improvement Plan is generally reviewed and updated annually around April. The projects listed in the plan are organized by categories A, B, and C—based on funding available; A – are projects that are approved and funded, B – projects pending implementation, C – future/planned projects.

New projects added in the previous year were: office building, vaulted restrooms, and lift station at Modesto Reservoir; Laird Park picnic shelter; and, solar lighting and walking paths for Empire and Bonita Ranch Park.

Projects listed in the CIP: Frank Raines Regional Park water system improvements (still in progress), Heron Point project at Woodward Reservoir (completed), vaulted toilet installation at Woodward Reservoir (completed), Woodward Reservoir park improvements (in progress), Frank Raines OHV Park fencing (pending available funds), Salida parks and streetscaping urban conservation water supply (completed), Modesto Reservior park improvements (pending available funds), Shiloh fishing access development (pending available funds), Frank Raines Regional Park upgrade (partially completed/pending available funds), Fairview Park playground equipment and restroom replacement (pending available funds), Hatch Park playground equipment and restroom replacement (pending available funds), Hatch Park ball field improvements (pending available funds), Frank Raines Regional Park day use area and playground (partially completed/pending available funds), Frank Raines Regional Park hall restoration and rehabilitation project (pending available funds), La Grange Regional Park improvements (pending available funds).

*The Fairview Park project will be reviewed for the current volunteer renovation efforts. Improvement to the entryway area of the park is an important priority for vehicle access to the park.
