- 6. A donation was received for a preservation coating service on the Chief Estanislao structure and fountain in downtown Modesto from Tony Mistlin. This preservation repair is expected to last another twenty years.
- 7. The Department was awarded the OHV grants on a preliminary basis with a thirty day waiting period. Frank Raines received approximately \$500,000 and La Grange \$300,000. The OHV parks have been frequented by various OHV events/groups.
