D.	STAFF REPORTS	ACTIONS & REPORTER
1.	Woodward Reservoir had another successful fireworks show this year along with the hot weather. Staff are gearing up for the Symbiosis event in September. T-Island campground is in the process of being upgraded with electrical and septic access. The approval for this project will go to the Board on August 18 <sup>th</sup> .	Merry Mayhew
2.	The waterfowl draw just passed with select hunting spots remaining due to the water level this year. The Department generally notifies all hunters on file and post on the home webpage of the draw event activities.	
3.	Modesto Reservoir and La Grange Regional Park reported some vandalism repairs. The OHV portion is in the off-season. The full OHV grants were awarded to both OHV parks.	
4.	The restrooms are now open at Parklawn Park with an auto-lock system.	
5.	Efforts are in progress on establishing radio communication coverage out at Frank Raines Regional Park. The Department has been working with Regional 911 and other agencies interested in the matter.	
6.	Manos Unidos is continuing to work with the Department on a plan for Fairview	Joseph Sanchez

7. Recruitments will include seven full-time positions with three of those positions assigned to community parks.

8.	New picnic tables and fencing are being placed out at Oregon Park to aide PAL in their programs. The neighborhood community has been actively involved in the park's recent improvements.	
9.	Public Works has a retrofit project at Geer Road utilizing part of Fox Grove Fish Access for staging.	
10.	The Quagga Mussel grant is being used to bring in dogs for boat inspections. There is a preventative plan/process in place for the invasive species.	
11.	A recent fund request to restock both the reservoir's supply of fish was denied due to the drought. The Department was asked to resubmit this request in the Winter.	
12.	Various grants and PFF fund requests are in progress for several sites, which included Woodward Reservoir and Fairview Park. See Staff Report for more details.	
13.	The Department provided a 'celebrate parks' presentation to the Board on July 28 <sup>th</sup> as an awareness effort for Parks and Recreation month.	
14.	Commissioners briefly discussed the importance of surveying Las Palmas to accurately identify property lines. A suggestion was made for the Department to include in the letter of intent to the adjacent property owner, a pre-estimated option to correctly adjust the current fencing encroachment. There is a possibility that the existing fencing may have been placed prior to the current property owner. A draft will be submitted to Counsel for approval.	Ron West Jami Aggers Merry Mayhew
